### **We will be..**

Developing fine motor skills using tools such as scissors in DT activities to make Little Red Hens and windmills.

We will also be practising pencil control in writing activities and finger gym exercises.

We will be developing gross motor skills in PE and outdoor play, including body strength, balance, co-ordination and agility.

### **We will be..**

We will also be learning the sounds that letters make and using them to spell and read simple words in Sounds-Write Phonics.

### **We will be..**

Developing speaking and listening skills. We will learn and use new vocabulary linked to the theme "Let's Celebrate" and the story of "The Little Red Hen".

## Personal, Social and Emotional Development

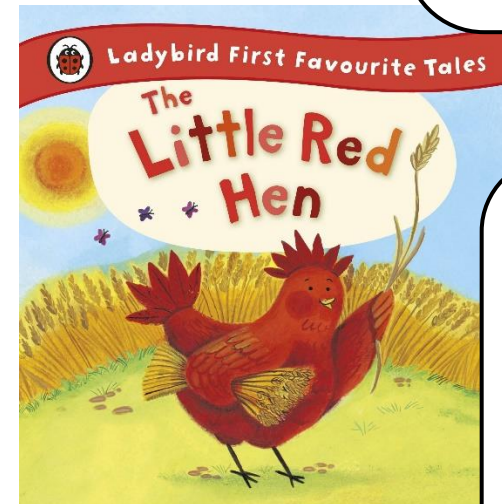
### **We will be..**

## Understanding the World

### **We will be..**

Finding out about different celebrations including birthdays, harvest festival, Diwali, Hanukkah and Christmas.

We will also be looking at seasonal changes and learning about Autumn.

Within RE lessons we will be learning about the Christian festival of harvest. We will also learn about celebrations in other faiths.

## Numeracy: Number

### **We will be..**

Learning and recognising numbers 0-5 through number games and interactive activities. We will provide opportunities for the children to gain an understanding of what each number looks and feels like through various counting activities.

We will be making repeating patterns using various resources - such as paint to print with.

We will also be learning about 2D shapes and how to describe them using mathematical language, as well as playing and exploring with shapes to see what new shapes we can make.

## Expressive Arts and Design

### **We will be learning to..**

Recognise the primary colours and watch how these change through colour mixing and design to create Autumn paintings. Making Rangoli patterns as part of our work on Diwali.

During music activities we will be exploring and experimenting by expressing our feelings and responses when listening and moving to music.

Through role-play we will be developing our own storylines.
